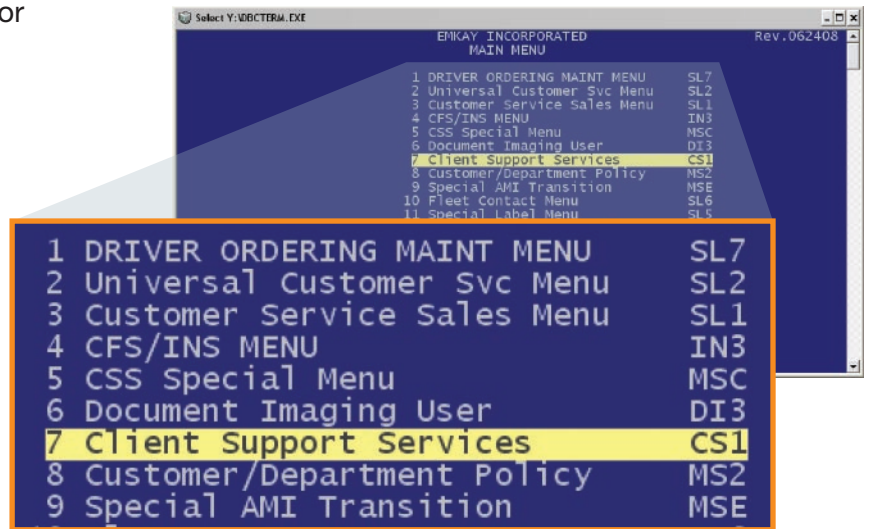




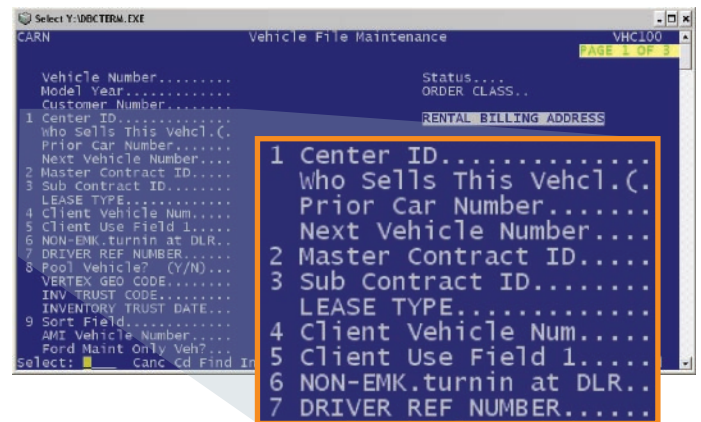

HOW TO UPDATE VEHICLE CLIENT USE FIELDS

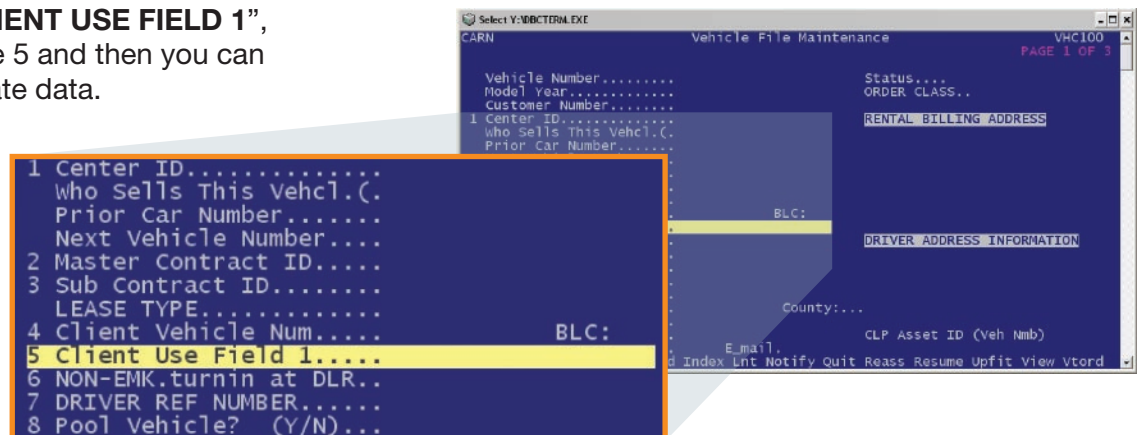
- 1** From the Main Menu, select the option for “**CLIENT SUPPORT SERVICES CS1**”.



- 2** Then, **SELECT** option 1 “**VEHICLE FILE MAINTENANCE**”.



- 3** To update the “**CLIENT USE FIELD 1**”, input **5** to enter line 5 and then you can input the appropriate data.

- 4** Then, press the **MINUS (-) SIGN** on the number keyboard once to move to **PAGE 3** of the screen.
